- presented works must be ready to hang with appropriate screw eyes or d-rings on the back
- large works (over 1m. longest side) and works for plinths or floor may be accepted. Please discuss with Events Co-ordinator, Tudor Caradoc-Davies, 021 067 4902
- work should be dry so there is no chance of paint damaging other works
- donation of 20% will be charged by OpenArts Inc. for works sold to cover administration and costs.
Please note that if items are bought by Credit Card, an extra 5% will be added to the 20%.
- 'swing tags' should be attached to works entered with name of artist, title, selling price
- late entries i.e. after 19th March, may incur a \$20.00 fee per work and will not be accepted after 26 March 2010
- ENTRY MAY BE RESTRICTED depending on number of entries and space available

N.B.

1. Insurance, as usual, is the responsibility of people entering the works in the exhibition. You may wish to discuss this with your insurance firm. We will take every possible steps to ensure that your work is not damaged while in our care.
2. Work should be taken to the Macandrew Bay Hall, on Wednesday 31 March 2010 between 10am and noon. If this is not possible, please contact the Co-ordinator by Monday 29 March to make alternative arrangements.
3. Sold/unsold work should be collected from the Hall on Sunday 11 April between 4 and 6pm.
4. The Event Co-ordinator will contact you in March to arrange suitable time/s for you to assist with looking after the Exhibition during its run.
